- 19 1. On or about June 24, 2004 the former Bureau for Private Postsecondary and
20 Vocational Education¹ issued a full approval to operate (Non-Accredited) to the Intercultural
21 Institute Of California, a Non-Profit Corporation, (School Code No. 3801931).
 - 22 2. The approval to operate expired on May 20, 2011, and has not been renewed.
 - 23 3. On or about May 16, 2011, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education received
24 a renewal application for an approval to operate a non-accredited institution from the Intercultural
25 Institute of California. The members of the Intercultural Institute of California's Board of

26 ¹ The former Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education sunsetted on
27 July 1, 2007. On October 11, 2009, the Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 (AB 48)
28 was signed into law. The Act, which became operative on January 1, 2010, established the
Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education.

1 Directors each certified under penalty of perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and
2 representations in the application. The Bureau denied the application on September 15, 2015.
3 The Intercultural Institute of California appealed that denial and a Statement of Issues is pending
4 against Respondent.


5 4. On or about March 22, 2016, Joanne Wenzel, Chief of the Bureau for Private
6 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs (Bureau), solely in her official
7 capacity, filed Statement of Issues number 1001078.

8 5. A hearing on the Statement of Issues has been scheduled for June 7-8, 2017.

9 6. The Bureau hereby withdraws Statement of Issues No. 1001078. The basis for this
10 withdrawal is that on May 12, 2017, the Bureau's counsel received Intercultural Institute of
11 California's Notice of Withdrawal of Request for Hearing.

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13 WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues number 1001078
14 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
