22 TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

23 On or about July 27, 2016, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau)
24 received an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs for
25 Non-Accredited Institutions for Advanced Vocational Institute, from Rashad M. Said and Joanne
26 Winterberg (Respondents). On or about July 24, 2016, Rashad M. Said certified under penalty of
27 perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and representations in the application. The
28 Bureau denied the application on November 5, 2018. On December 21, 2018, the Bureau

1 received a request for a hearing to appeal the Bureau's denial of the application from
2 Respondents. On June 20, 2019, Dr. Michael Marion, Jr., solely in his official capacity as Chief
3 of the Bureau, filed Statement of Issues Case No. 1004060, which is currently pending against
4 Respondents.

5 On December 27, 2019, Respondents withdrew their appeal and request for a hearing of the
6 denial of the Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs
7 for Non-Accredited Institutions for Advanced Vocational Institute by the Bureau for Private
8 Postsecondary Education. Accordingly, Statement of Issues No. 1004060, filed against
9 Respondents, is withdrawn without prejudice and the denial of the application is affirmed.
