20 1. On or about April 27, 2021, Deborah Cochrane, Chief of the Bureau for Private
21 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs (hereinafter "Bureau"), filed
22 Statement of Issues No. 1006656 solely in her official capacity.

23 2. On or about September 6, 2019, the Bureau received an Application for Renewal of
24 Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited from Dynasty Trucking School, Inc., Jimmy
25 Peng, Owner of Dynasty Trucking School (Respondent). The Bureau denied the application on
26 or about November 2, 2020.

27 3. The basis for withdrawing the pending Statement of Issues is that on or about May
28 12, 2021, Respondent withdrew its appeal and request for a hearing of the denial of its application

1 for Renewal of Approval to Operate a Non-Accredited Institution by the Bureau for Private
2 Postsecondary Education

3 4. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No. 1006656
4 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
