24 letters to Respondent on April 3, 2014, September 30, 2015 and January 11, 2017.


25 2. On August 17, 2017, the Bureau denied Respondent's Application for Approval to  
26 Operate. On or about August 24, 2017, Respondent requested an administrative hearing to appeal  
27 the Bureau's denial of its application.  
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1           3.     On January 25, 2018, Dr. Michael Marion, Jr., Chief of the Bureau for Private  
2 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Statement of Issues No.  
3 1002903, solely in his official capacity. After the filing of that Statement of Issues, Respondent  
4 provided additional documents intended to resolve issues of non-compliance in Respondent's  
5 Application.

6           4.     The Bureau hereby withdraws Statement of Issues No. 1002903. The basis for the  
7 withdrawal of this pleading is that Respondent has now provided the documents and other  
8 information necessary for its renewal of licensure.

9           5.     WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No.  
10 1002903 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
