22 1. On or about June 22, 2017, Joanne Wenzel, former Chief of the Bureau for Private
23 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs (Bureau), filed Statement of Issues
24 No. 1002114 solely in her official capacity.


25 2. On or about April 11, 2012, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau)
26 received an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited from
27 The Coaches Training Institute (Respondent). Subsequently, the Bureau and Respondent
28 exchanged correspondence regarding Respondent's application, and on or about October 30,

1 2015, the Bureau received an updated application from Respondent. On or about April 6, 2016,
2 and June 1, 2016, the Bureau issued to Respondent letters explaining the deficiencies in its
3 updated application. On or about June 9, 2016, the Bureau received a response from Respondent.
4 On or about July 29, 2016, the Bureau issued to Respondent a Notice of Denial of Application for
5 Renewal of Approval to Operate. On or about September 22, 2016, the Bureau received a request
6 for an administrative hearing from Respondent.

7 3. The basis for withdrawing the pending Statement of Issues No. 1002114 is that
8 Respondent has now provided the documents and other information necessary for its renewal of
9 approval to operate.

10 4. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No.
11 1002114 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
