• "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

• "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

• "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

• "Salary" is as reported by the graduate or graduate's employer.

"No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school
was not able to obtain salary information.
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Student's Right to Cancel

New students have the right to cancel their program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through the attendance of their first class session or the seventh (7th) day of enrollment, whichever is later. This time frame is called "THE CANCELLATION PERIOD". If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of money not paid from federal student financial aid program funds. A student may cancel his/her enrollment agreement in any manner (by writing, phone, fax, e-mail, letter, or in person. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail and properly addressed with proper postage.
