21 1. On or about May 19, 2020, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education,
22 Department of Consumer Affairs (hereinafter Bureau), received an Application for Significant
23 Change in Method of Instructional Delivery (application number 33312) from Respondent.
24 Respondent sought approval to offer a change in the learning style from in-person to temporary
25 distance learning via online instruction due to the California COVID-19 Shelter-in-Place
26 Government Order restricting in-person classes.
