The Commission on English Program Accreditation (CEA) is recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education for the accreditation of English language programs in accredited universities and colleges and independent English language schools. CEA's recognition allows accredited English language organizations to use their CEA accreditation for certification by SEVP (Department of Homeland Security) to admit international students.

In accordance with Section 602.26 of the U.S. Secretary of Education's *Recognition of Accrediting Agencies*, a recognized accrediting agency must notify state agencies that provide licensing for English language schools of its accreditation decisions.
