27 an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs for Non-
28 Accredited Institutions from Pathways College, LLC, Nursing & Health Care Careers

1 (Respondent). On or about June 17, 2016, Brenda J. Allmond, MSN, RN and Chief Executive
2 Officer for Pathways College, LLC, Nursing & Health Care Careers certified under penalty of
3 perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and representations in the application. After
4 several notices of deficiencies and some further information from Respondent, on or about
5 February 7, 2019, the Bureau denied the application. On or about September 23, 2019, the
6 Bureau received a letter from Respondent requesting an administrative hearing.

7 3. The basis for withdrawing the pending Statement of Issues number 1004369 is that
8 Respondent has now provided the documents and other information necessary to cure all
9 deficiencies and receive a Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs for
10 Non-Accredited Institutions.
