22 On or about September 11, 2017, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau),
23 Department of Consumer affairs, received an application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and
24 Offer Educational Programs for Non-Accredited Institutions from The Professional School of
25 Psychology (Respondent). On or about September 11, 2017, William Bergquist, Chief Executive
26 Officer, certified under penalty of perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and
27 representations in the application. The Bureau denied the application on August 22, 2019. On
28 October 17, 2019, the Bureau received a request for a hearing to appeal the Bureau's denial of the

1 application from Respondent. On April 30, 2020, Dr. Michael Marion Jr., solely in his official
2 capacity as the Chief of the Bureau, filed Statement of Issues No. 1005193, which is currently
3 pending against Respondent.

4 On August 7, 2020, Respondent withdrew the appeal and request for a hearing of the denial
5 of its application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs for Non-
6 Accredited Institutions for The Professional School of Psychology by the Bureau. Accordingly,
7 Statement of Issues No. 1005193, filed against Respondent, is withdrawn without prejudice and
8 the denial of the application is affirmed.
