**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF
STATEMENT OF ISSUES**

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

1. On or about July 21, 2011, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education ("Bureau") received an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited (application number 23779) from Qbics Career College (Respondent), Ehky Gutierrez owner. On or about May 18, 2012, the Bureau sent Respondent a deficiency letter. Between July 11, 2012 and October 7, 2015, the Bureau and Respondent exchanged correspondence regarding Respondent's application.


1 2. On or about December 29, 2015, the Bureau issued Respondent a Notice of Denial of
2 Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate. On or about January 5, 2016, the Bureau
3 received a request for an administrative hearing from Respondent. On or about January 11, 2016,
4 the Bureau received additional documents from Respondent intended to resolve issues of non-
5 compliance in Respondent's application.

6 3. On or about March 28, 2016, Joanne Wenzel, Chief of the Bureau for Private
7 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Statement of Issues No.
8 1001322 solely in her official capacity. After the filing of that Statement of Issues, Respondent
9 provided additional documents intended to resolve issues of non-compliance in Respondent's
10 application.

11 4. The Bureau hereby withdraws Statement of Issues No. 1001322. The basis for the
12 withdrawal of this pleading is that Respondent has now provided the documents and other
13 information necessary for its renewal of approval to operate.

14 5. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No.
15 1001322 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
