SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT

Silicon Valley International University (SVIU) received its approval to legally operate in the State of California on July 18, 2011. This means that it has met all regulatory requirements to provide the educational programs offered, and is approved as a private postsecondary educational institution in the State of California.

Per California Education Code Section 94910, qualified or approved private postsecondary educational institutions in California are required to provide students with a School Performance Fact Sheet containing specified information. However, when a school is too new to provide the data specified in this law, it is required to provide the following disclosure statement on its fact sheet:
