PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET 2011

We keep track of how our students are doing in respect to graduation and placement rates. We hope that this Information will help inform you of our school's success for the 2011 calendar year.

COSMETOLOGY

- * 74% or 66 of 89 students scheduled to graduate in 2011 went on to graduate.
- * 89% or 50 of 56 students that took the state board exam in 2011 and received their license
- * 74% or 60 of 81 graduates went on to work in the Beauty Industry/Profession full-time

ESTHETICIAN

- * 95% or 44 of 46 students scheduled to graduate in 2011 went on to graduate.
- * 100% or 40 of 40 students that took the state board exam in 2011 and received their license.
- * 76% or 35 of 46 graduates started working in the Beauty Industry/Profession full time.

MANICURING

- * 85% or 6 of 7 students scheduled to graduate in 2011 went on to graduate.
- * 100% or 6 of 6 students that took the state board exam in 2011 and received their license.
- * 83% or 5 of 6 graduates started working in the Beauty Industry/Profession full-time

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

- * 100% or 3 of 3 students scheduled to graduate in 2011 went on to graduate
- * 100% or 3 of 3 students started working in the beauty industry/profession full-time
