

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET FOR YEAR 2010 AND 2011

In compliance with the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, approved schools are required to provide a School Performance Fact Sheet. California National University for Advanced Studies (CNU) provides the following information for the 2010-2011 School Performance Fact Sheet.

- Completion rates for all programs offered: In the academic year of 2011, CNU had a completion rate 65%; In the academic year of 2010, CNU had a completion rate 45%.

The completion rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates by the number of students available for graduation.

It is important to state that the California National University for Advanced Studies is a small university that continues traditional educational approach through Online practice. CNU Students are working adults that are sometimes funded by their Employers; many have felt the measure of the economic downsize through educational benefits, which slows down their progress through their studies.

The California National University for Advance Studies is current in remitting Student Tuition Recovery Fund assessments.
