The majority of the student body at Nobel University consists of international students. These students are in the United States for the sole purpose of receiving an education; not for employment. International students are not eligible to work in this country. Thus employment figures for these student graduates are unavailable or irrelevant. Typically, students who complete their program at Nobel University have the option of either returning to their home country or continuing on with their education at Nobel University or another institution.
