ELS Language Centers offers English as a Second Language Instruction to non-immigrant students, and is authorized by the Department of Homeland Security to issue SEVIS Form I-20 to admitted students. As ELS offers no vocational training nor confers any degree, diploma, or certificate to graduates for meeting employment categories, and as ELS students are engaged in Second Language Learning, ELS students are not eligible for employment and ELS provides no placement services.

The following performance fact sheets for 2010 and 2011 are based solely on unique students to ELS Language Centers, who enrolled for a 4-week program, during the respective years. The completion rate is based upon completion of the initial 4-week program.

¹ "Number of Students Who Began Program" is the number of students who began the program who are scheduled to complete the program within the reporting calendar year.

² "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began program minus the number of "Students unavailable for graduation" which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

³ "Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

⁴ "Completion Rate" is the number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.

ELS does not track 150% completion rates, as this metric has no meaning equivalency for our program.

ELS does not offer vocational training, and, therefore, does not provide placement services. As such, placement rates are not applicable to the program we offer.

ELS's program does not qualify students to sit for any placement exam. As such, examination passage rates are not applicable to the program we offer.

ELS's students are not eligible for authorized employment nor does ELS place students for employment purposes. As such, Salary and Wage Information is not applicable to our students or the outcome of the program we offer.
