

STUDENT PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET FOR 2011-2012

The Hatlen Center for the Blind is required to report annually to the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, and to publish this report in the School Performance Fact Sheet. As a student, you are encouraged to review this information prior to signing an enrollment agreement.

- A. COHORT START DATE AND COHORT POPULATION: Since The Hatlen Center for the Blind is a year round program and students enter and exit throughout the year, the start dates and graduation dates vary. The program is individualized according to the student's particular needs. Students stay about a year on average; however some students are ready to graduate with a certificate earlier, while some students take longer than a year. For the purpose of reporting school performance, the calendar year from January through the end of December for the year in question shall be used. The current reporting data is from **January 2011 through December 2011**. The "cohort population" shall be those students in the program during the calendar year in question.
- B. COMPLETION RATE: 31 students total were enrolled in 2011. Of the 31 students enrolled, 14 students graduated, an additional 14 students were in the middle of the program and not ready to graduate in 2011, 1 student voluntarily left the program without a certificate, and 2 students were expelled for infringement of school rules. **The completion rate is 100%** (14 students were available for graduation, 14 students graduated).
- C. THE JOB PLACEMENT RATE: The Hatlen Center for the Blind is not designed or advertised to lead to a particular career, or advertised or promoted with any claim regarding job placement. This reporting requirement does not apply.
- D. THE LICENSE EXAMINATION PASSAGE RATES: The Hatlen Center does not provide a program that leads to employment for which passage of a state licensing examination is required. This reporting requirement does not apply.
- E. SALARY AND WAGE INFORMATION: The Hatlen Center does not provide a program that leads to employment in a specific field. This reporting requirement does not apply.
- F. LIST OF EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS USED TO DETERMINE THE NUMBER OF GRADUATES EMPLOYED IN THE FIELD: Does not apply.
