1. “Number of Students That Began Program” is the number of students that began the program and completed within the same reporting calendar year. In this case we are reporting for the calendar years 2009 & 2010.
2. “Students Available for Graduation” means the number of students who began the program less students who were not able to complete for any one of the following reasons: death, total disabling illness, incarceration, and active military service.
3. “Graduates” indicates the number of students that began the program and completed as scheduled. Since the program is nine months in length these graduates completed within nine months.
4. “Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program within the stated length of time divided by the number of students available for graduation.
5. Some students may need to take longer to complete the program for multiple reasons. Students must graduate within 150% of original program length to earn a diploma. Students who do not complete within 150% are terminated and do not earn a diploma. To come up with the 150% mark we multiply this way: 9 months program length X 1.5 = 13.5 months.
6. “150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who graduated within 101% to 150% of the program length. This rate is determined by dividing the number of completions by the number of available for graduation.

International students are not part of this calculation since their visas do not make them permanent residents of the United States and must return to their country of origin.
4. “Graduates Employed in the Field” are graduates who report that they became gainfully employed within six months of graduation in a position for which the skills and knowledge obtained through the training provided by the institution were required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.
5. “Placement Rate” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
