2. "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who are gainfully employed within six months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.
3. Salary is as reported by the student. Not all graduated reported salary.

Positions used to determine the number of graduates employed in the field for purposes of calculating job placement rates include installation technicians, commissioning technicians, operations and maintenance technicians, assembly technicians, and floor hands.

Sources for salary and wages include company hiring managers and graduating students.
