Court Reporting (Information based on the student’s expected graduation date)

AAS Degree **102 students (D/N) started and were expected to graduate with an AAS Degree in 2011 (This information is based on 3 years for days and 4 years for nights)**

Completion 2% or 2 out of 102 students went on to graduate with an AAS degrees on time or earlier.*
(When students pass the CSR Examination, most of them do not continue for the AAS degree, they complete the Certificate Program.)

CSR Exam 100% or 2 out of 2 students (with an AAS degree) who took the CSR examination passed the CSR examination in 2011 first time

Placement 100% or 2 out of 2 students graduated with an AAS degree obtained a job in the field or in a related field

Certificate **10 students (D/N) started the AAS degree program and changed to the Certificate program were expected to graduate with a Certificate in 2011**

Completion 100% or 10 out of 10 students went on graduate with a certificate on time or earlier*

CSR Exam 100% or 10 out of 10 students (with a Certificate) who took the CSR examination passed the CSR examination in 2011

Placement 100% or 10 out of 10 students graduated with a Certificate and were available for employment and obtained a job in the field or in a related field

*Because of the difference in skill attainment standards between the South Coast College AAS degree (NCRA standard--225 wpm) and the California Certified Shorthand Reporters Board (less than NCRA—200 wpm), many court reporting students enrolled in the AAS degree who pass the state examination because they have attained the 200 wpm requirement will leave South Coast College with a Certificate upon attaining the 200 wpm skill level.

Salary information: Difficult to ascertain. Students do not like to disclose salary figures Court reporting salaries vary depending upon whether reporters are court or deposition reporters.

CSR Examination Passage Rate (Certified Shorthand Reporter Examination-State of California)

Year 2011 – Based on actual Passage Rate (students completed earlier included)

AAS Degree 0 students took the CSR examination first time

Certificate 15 students took the CSR examination first time
40% or 6 out of 15 students passed the examination first time
9 students did not pass the exam first time
5 students out of 9 who did not pass first time passed exam on 2nd time
100% or 6 out of 6 who passed examination first time obtained a job in the field

Salary: Students do not like to disclose salary figures.

Year 2010 – Based on actual Passage Rate (students completed earlier included)

AAS Degree 1 students took the CSR examination first time
100% or 1 of 1 student passed the examination first time
100% or 1 of 1 student who passed the examination the first time obtained a job in the field
Salary: Student’s first year salary reported was estimated to be over \$90,000.

Certificate 21 students took the CSR examination first time
33% or 7 out of 21 students passed the examination first time
14 students did not pass the exam first time
86% or 6 out of 7 students who passed examination the first time obtained a job in the field
Salary: One student reported her first-year salary estimated to be over \$100,000.
