<sup>2</sup>CMU requests job titles on the annual alumni survey enclosed, however the responses are typically multiple variations that are difficult to quantify, therefore the data is compiled by industry and job function. The Master of Arts degree in Education employment data concludes that 78% of alumni are in the position of Educator, and within Educator, 73% are K-12 and 20% are postsecondary education.

Invitations to 22 alumni from calendar year 2011 were sent on August 14, 2012, followed by one reminder sent on August 21, 2012; there was one email that bounced back as undeliverable. Collection of survey responses was closed on August 24. A total of 4 responses were received for an overall response rate of 19%. The resulting sample of 4 is not sufficient to draw conclusions about CMU’s California alumni, but the results are presented in this summary to comply with California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education requirements.
