2. **Exam Pass Rate.** Only the master's program leads to licensure; however, the masters programs are new so no one has yet met the requirements to sit for an exam. The Psy.D. program does not prepare anyone to sit for a license.
3. **Placement.** Most of the students are currently working in their chosen field. No data is available since it was not tracked for the prior period. Now that notice has been received, the next cohort will be notified that placement information will be requested.
4. **Salaries.** This varies greatly in that many students already are licensed and/or are working. No claim is made as to annual starting salaries or as to the state of the job market. Since we have not as yet collected data for the recent graduates, the salaries were not tracked and thus, there is no overall starting salary. We have received notice to collect said data and beginning with our next cohort, we will be requesting salary and placement information six months after graduation. Eisner Institute for Professional Studies does not offer direct employment placement assistance.
