Definitions:

"Number of students who began the program" means students who began a program and who are scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting *Calendar year*.

"Number of Graduates" the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year, from the number of students who began the program (*see definition above*)

150% Completion rate means students that graduated after their contract grad date up to 150% of the published program length.
