



SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET

In compliance with the California Postsecondary Education Act of 2009, University of the People provides the following Statements of Fact.

The Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (BPPE), as the regulatory body for private postsecondary institutions for the State of California, requires that each institution provide the following information to students, prior to enrollment, as evidence of recognition of the need to address consumer protection:

- Completion rates for each program of instruction;
- Placement rates for each program of instruction;
- License-examination rates for any program to which that statistic is applicable;
- Salary or wage information for each career, occupation, trade, job, or job title, as applicable, for which students are prepared.

University of the People currently offers four degree programs:

- Associate of Science in Business Administration (AS-BA)
- Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BS-BA)
- Associate of Science in Computer Science (AS-CS)
- Bachelor of Science in Computer Science (BS-CS)

All of the educational programs offered by University of the People started in September 2009 and are therefore too new to provide data for any of the categories listed above. Thus, the number of students who graduate, the number of students who are placed, or the starting salaries you can earn after finishing the educational program are unknown at this time. Information regarding general salary and placement statistics may be available from government sources or from the institution, but it is not equivalent to actual performance data.

It should also be noted that none of the educational programs offered by University of the People are designed to lead to, and University of the People does not make any express or implied claim related to preparing students for, a particular career, occupation, vocation, job, or job title. Similarly, University of the People does not make any express or implied claim about the salary that may be earned after completing any of its educational programs.
