School Performance Fact Sheet

The **mission** of California Christian College is to prepare men and women, through quality Bible-based Christian education, to serve Christ in His church and throughout society.

The College offers the following **degrees**: Associate of Arts in Bible and Christian Ministry
Bachelor of Arts in Bible and Christian Ministry
Bachelor of Arts in Bible and Theology

Degree programs at California Christian College include a **Christian Service** component, providing practical application of classroom instruction. All students are required to complete approximately 20 hours of approved Christian Service each semester. Students' Christian Service is monitored and is a requirement for graduation.

The following information is provided in keeping with requirements established by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education of the State of California:

- Completion rates:** The completion rate* for students at California Christian College rarely drops below 100%.
- Placement rates:** Programs at California Christian College are not designed to prepare students for one specific career, occupation, job, or job title. Some graduates enter full-time Christian ministry. Others continue their education in graduate school. Some use their Christian training to make an impact in careers in the larger workforce.
- License examination passage rates:** Programs at California Christian College do not prepare students for specific (state) licensing exams.
- Salary/Wage information:** No attempt is made to track salary/wage information for graduates of California Christian College. In many ways, such data would contradict the mission and purpose of the institution. The nature of the degrees offered often results in graduates serving in volunteer capacities in church/parachurch ministries or functioning bi-vocationally in both the ministry and the marketplace. The salaries of graduates who do enter full-time Christian ministry vary so widely that no meaningful figure can be determined.
