SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET CALENDAR YEAR 2012

Section 94910 of the California Private Postsecondary Education Act (CPPEA) of 2009, effective January 1, 2011, requires schools to provide information regarding the completion rates, placement rates, licensure exam passage rates, and salary/wage information for each of their programs offered. The following information has been compiled for the applicable reporting periods of January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012 and January 1, 2011 and December 31, 2011.

In reviewing the information reported below, please keep in mind the following:

- Southern Baptist College and Seminary (SBCS) is a small institution with a limited student enrollment.
- As a seminary, SBCS is unique and differs from traditional higher education institutions in that our students devote their lives to a religious vocation and work in places of worship as ministers, evangelists, deacons, and the like upon completion of their studies. As such, there is no license examination requirement and license examination passage rates are not applicable. Also, the religious nature of the employment and vocation account for the relatively low annual salary and wages.
- Nearly all of the students at SBCS are non-traditional students who are already serving full-time as pastors or lay ministers in churches and other religious organizations. Due to family, professional and vocational obligations, most of our full-time students register for only the minimum required number of credits each semester. As such, most of our students are unable to complete their degree programs within the published program period. Many students also enroll at SBCS on a part-time basis to enhance their existing job skills and to acquire more knowledge in their respective fields of employment.

Therefore, the above factors and circumstances substantially impact the statistical data below.
