

## **SCHOOL PERFORMANCE SHEET for University of Los Angeles**

The California Private Postsecondary Education Act (CPPEA) of 2009, effective January 1, 2010, requires under section 94910 of the Act that a school provide information for each program offered in regards to completion rates. The following information is data compiled for the calendar year of January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012.

<sup>1</sup> “Number of Students who began the Program” is the number of students who began the program who are scheduled to complete the program within the reporting calendar year.

<sup>2</sup> “Student available for graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of “Students unavailable for graduation”, which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

<sup>3</sup> “Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

<sup>4</sup> “Completion Rate (100%)” is the number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students available for Graduation.
