Doctor of Ministry Program was in dormant for many years; it was just started in 2010. Therefore, this program is considered new, the number of students to be graduated, or placed in employment, or the possible starting salary after completing the education program are unknown at this time. Information regarding general salary and placement statistics may be available from government sources or from the institution, but is not equivalent to actual performance data. Besides, eligibal candidates for entering the Doctor of Ministry Program must be ministers in full-time positions already.
