<sup>1</sup> “Number of students who began semester” is the number of students who registered for between one and seven courses for that semester.

<sup>2</sup> “Number of students available for completion” is the number of students who began the semester minus the number of students “unavailable for completion”, which means those students who have died, been incarcerated, or called to active military duty.

<sup>3</sup> “Number of students who completed” is the number of students who passed all the courses for which they registered with a grade of C- or above.

<sup>4</sup> “Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the semester divided by the number of students available for completion.

**C. RATE OF EMPLOYMENT**

This program offers coursework (credits) to be used towards a Bachelor's Degree in Liberal Arts and as such does not prepare students for specific employment or occupation.

**D. SALARY AND WAGE INFORMATION**

This program does not prepare students for specific employment or occupation and as such cannot provide salary or wage information.

**E. NOTICE CONCERNING TRANSFERABILITY OF CREDITS EARNED AT MAALOT LOS ANGELES.**

All credits earned from Maalot are certified by the National College Credit Recommendation Service (NCCRS formerly known as PONSI) and will be applied towards a degree at Thomas Edison State College of New Jersey. In the event that a student wishes to transfer to a different school, the student would need to verify if that school accepts NCCRS credits. While many schools do, it is not universal and needs to be confirmed with the individual school. In general, when students transfer from one school to another, it is the prerogative of the admitting school to review prior credits and grant only those from courses they deem comparable to their own course offerings.
