ELS Language Centers offers the following facts on the performance of students enrolled at our 9 California Centers:

Rate of successful completion: For the 2012 academic year, 15,325 students¹ enrolled in an Intensive English Program in the 9 ELS Language Centers in California. Of those, 14,957 students² completed the session(s) in which they enrolled, resulting in a Completion rate of 97.5%.

Statement on rate of employment, job placement, and licensure pass rate: ELS Language Centers only offers instruction for English as a Second Language and does not place students for employment purposes nor does it prepare students to pass vocational and/or professional licensures.
