The data reflected in the above charts was gathered using at least one of the following methods: School Records, Graduate Surveys, Employer Surveys and the State's Employment Development Department.

Employment opportunities vary from Spas, Salons with Spa services, Chiropractor and Physical Therapist offices as well as the individual's own practice. The Institution maintains a Bulletin Board where current employment opportunities are announced.

Data provided by the Employment Development Department's Occupational Employment Statistics states that the average wage for Massage Therapists is \$18.55 / hr. and an annual salary of \$38,584.00 for those employed on a full time basis. Typical starting revenue for a Massage Practitioner/Therapist working as an independent contractor is \$35 / session.
