**SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET**

Program Descriptions:

*Nursing Assistant Training Program – 150 hours*

Prepare the Nurse Assistant Student for the State of California Nursing Assistant Competency Evaluation. Certification is after satisfactorily completion of the course program and passing of the California State Examination. This course introduces the students to the role of a nursing assistant with instruction in basic skills and competencies. Theory classes will be held in the class room and clinical hours will be at the contracted training facilities or laboratory.

*Home Health Aide – 40 hours*

A 40 hours supplemental theory and clinical training course program which helps prepare the Nurse Assistant Student or CNA become a Certified Home Health Aide. Theory classes will be held in the classroom and clinical hours will be at the contracted training facilities or laboratory.

There is no reciprocity granted for HHA's. One may not work as a Certified Home Health Aide until he/she is cleared for criminal convictions and received an HHA certificate. The school is an eligible CA. Training Provider, but does not offer any other Federal and State Financial Aid.

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### **94910. Minimum Requirements for School Performance Fact**

Prior to enrollment, an institution shall provide a prospective student with a school performance Sheet containing at a minimum, the following information, as it relates to the educational program:

- (a) Completion rates, as calculated pursuant to article 16 (commencing with Section 94928).
- (b) Placement rates, as calculated pursuant to article 16 (commencing with Section 94928), if the educational program is designed to lead to, or the institution makes any express or implied claim related to preparing students for, a particular career, occupation, vocation, job, or job title.
- (c) License examination passage rates for programs leading to employment for which passage of a state licensing examination is required, as calculated pursuant to article 16 (commencing with Section 94928).
- (d)
  - (1) Salary or wage information, as calculated pursuant to article 16 (commencing with Section 94928), if the institution or a representative of the institution makes any express or implied claim about the salary that may be earned completing the educational program.
  - (2) Additionally, each institution that offers an educational program designed to lead to a particular career, occupation, vocation, trade, job, or job title shall disclosed the wage and salary data for the particular career, occupation, trade, job, or job title, as provided by the Employment Development Department's Occupational Employment Statistics, if that data is available.
- (e) If a program is too new to provide data for any of the categories listed in this subdivision, the institution shall state on its fact sheet: "This program is new. Therefore, the number of students who graduate, the number of students who are placed, or the starting salary you can earn after finishing the educational program are unknown at this time. Information regarding general salary and placement statistics may be available from government sources or from the institution, but it is not equivalent to actual performance data."
- (f) All of the following:
  - (1) A description of the manner in which the figures described in subdivision (a) to (d), inclusive, are calculated or a statement informing the reader of where he or she may obtain a description of the manner in which the figures describe in subdivisions (a) to (d), inclusive, are calculated.

(2) A statement informing the reader of where he or she may obtain from the institution a list of the employment positions determined to be within the field for which a student received education and training for the calculation of job placement rates as required by subdivision (b).

(g) The following statements:

(1) "This fact sheet is filled with the BUREAU for Private Postsecondary Education. Regardless of any information you may have relating to completion rate, placement rates, starting salaries, or license exam pass rates, this fact sheet contains the information as calculated pursuant to state law."
