*All Loyola Montessori Graduate students have 5 years from their enrollment date to complete the CORE Education courses and graduate with their M.Ed. in Montessori Education. It is not unusual for students to wait a year after their AMI training is complete at the Montessori Institute of San Diego before enrolling in their CORE courses. Often, students find that having a year of teaching experience in a Montessori classroom is valuable during their M.Ed. coursework.
