(3) "Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

(4) "Completion Rate" is the number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.

(5) "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 101-150% of the published program length.

(6) "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 101-150% of the published program length divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation in the published program length period.

(4) "Graduated employed in the field" means graduates who report that they are gainfully employed within 6 months of graduation in a position for which the skills t\obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.

(5) "Placement Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

(1) "Graduates available for employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment. "Graduates unavailable for employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

(2) "Graduates employed in the field" means graduates who report that they are gainfully employed within 6 months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position.

Students may obtain from the placement department a list of employment positions determined to be within the field for which a student is receiving education and training for the calculation of job placement rates and may also obtain the sources of information used to substantiate the salary disclosure.

The figures calculated in this fact sheet are based on students who enrolled at BioHealth College, graduated from BioHealth College and obtained employment in the field. This information is maintained in their student records and stored with BioHealth College.

This fact sheet is filed with the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. Regardless of any information you may have relating to completion rates, placement rates, starting salaries or license exam passage rates, this fact sheet contains the information as calculated pursuant to state law.
