The San Jose Barber College is located at 1686 Monterey Highway, San Jose, California. The College has 1,800 square feet of floor space, fluorescent lighting and the most modern back bars. The ten feet ceiling affords adequate ventilation. There are two private toilets and washbasins for men and women, each equipped for the handicapped. Sanitary linen and supply cabinets are utilized. The college has an automatic sprinkler system overhead. There are 340 square feet used as the classroom and the locker room. The classroom contains usual library and instructional equipment, wall diagrams prescribed by the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. The premises contain heat and an air condition system.

The San Jose Barber College operates under the Laws and Regulations prescribed by the California State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists and the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education.

Entrance Requirements

Entrance requirements are prescribed by the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. Generally, these requirements consist of either proof of the 10th grade or its equivalent. Presenting good moral character is required but this does not exclude from admission those who have had unusual prior experiences. Minimum age for admission is 16 ½ years. The student is obligated to visit the college at least six days prior to starting class. The officials are obligated to provide the student with a thorough tour of the college facilities and to place a written statement, signed by the student and put in the student's file to verify that the visitation and tour were provided.

Enrollment Policy

The San Jose Barber college permits enrollment on any day (closed Sunday and Monday) Tuesday through Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Attendance Policy and Regulations

The college is glad to cooperate with students by advance arrangements for absence for medical care, weddings, funerals, etc..... However, whenever an absence is claimed excused by reason of illness or medical care, a certificate signed by the doctor is required.

Interruption for Unsatisfactory Attendance

Interruption for unsatisfactory progress or conduct run from three to thirty days and may be permanent. Disregard for school regulations constitutes sufficient reason for suspension. Any student is subject to suspension or interruption for unsatisfactory attendance.

Conditions of Re-Entrance

After formal interruption or suspension, students are permitted to resume the course with credit on the same enrollment only when the required hours can be completed with the months specified in the law and approval of the school.

Misconduct

In addition to the standards outlined above, any disorderly, rude or impolite conduct towards customers, staff or other students is cause for suspension or dismissal.

The San Jose Barber College does not discriminate because of a person's race, color, sex, religion, age, ancestry or natural origin.

The San Jose Barber College is dedicated to training students in various phases of barber styling.

The San Jose Barber College is open every day of the year except Sunday Monday and Holidays prescribed by Section 215 of the Regulations of the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

These holidays are New Year's Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. All other holidays proclaimed by the President of the United States and the Governor of California.

Credit Evaluation Policy

The San Jose Barber College accepts transfers from all other barber colleges accredited or licensed by the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. No financial penalty is required f the student who merely pays for the hours required to complete the course. All transfers are under the supervision and regulations of the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists. Full credit is given for work performed elsewhere whenever the transfer is approved or within the framework of approved regulations of the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

Special Cases

In the case of student's prolonged illness or accident, a death in the family or other circumstances that make it impractical to complete the course, the school shall make a settlement which is refundable and fair to both.

Course Objectives

The Educational Vocational objective of each course taught at San Jose Barber College is to prepare the student barber for the examination to become a Licensed Registered Barber. The courses taught are prescribed by the State Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists.

Attendance Pattern Permitted

40 hours a week – 38 weeks – 1500 clock hours

30 hours a week – 50 weeks - 1500 clock hours

20 hours a week – 75 weeks – 1500 clock hours

The above table explains the number of weeks required to complete the 1500 – hour course required by the State. When there is a variation from the usual eight hours a day five days a week. The same amount of class work and the same amount of total time required by the State is completed by each student, regardless of the time in daily attendance.

Students may be dismissed because they have no aptitude. It is not the policy of the school to accept tuition from students or their sponsors in these cases where it is apparent after a few days or weeks that the student will not ultimately qualify as a barber.

After satisfactorily completing all required practical services, theory and hours, San Jose Barber College graduates are given a Graduation Letter along with a Diploma in the Art and Science of Barbering.

Six - Day Cancellation

All monies paid by the applicant will be refunded if requested within six days after signing the enrollment agreement and making the initial payment. After the six day period but prior to starting classes students may terminate and receive a refund of all monies paid minus the enrollment fee.

Tuition Refund Policy

A student terminating training after entering school and starting classes shall be entitled to a prorated (hourly) refund minus the enrollment fee. Refunds will be made within thirty days of the termination date, which is the last date of the actual attendance by the student.
