



**SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FACT SHEET 2012**

This fact sheet is filed with the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. Regardless of any information you may have relating to completion rates, placement rates, starting salaries, or license exam passage rates, this fact sheet contains the information as calculated pursuant to state law.

In compliance with the California Postsecondary Education Act of 2009, Advance English Academy provides the following Statements of Fact.

In accordance with Article 16 (commencing with Section 94928 of the regulation) and our institutional definition of program completion, Advance English Academy calculated student completion rate as follows:

<sup>2</sup> “Students available for completion” is the number of students who attended the program minus the number of “Students unavailable for completion,” which means those students who have failed to fulfill our school’s completion criteria. The completion criterion is as follows:

- (1) Students have completed the highest level of ESL or TOEFL program, and/or;
- (2) Students have achieved their personal goals regardless of the length they stay in our school, and/or;
- (3) Students have fulfilled their academic goals within their time of enrollment.

<sup>3</sup> “Completion Rate” is the Number of Students Available for Completion divided by the Number of Students Who Attended the Program.
