Contra Costa Medical Career College provides educational opportunity to members of the community who are seeking stable and growing careers in the healthcare industry.

Completion Rates: An average 82% of students who begin a program successfully complete the program. Completion rate calculated by dividing the number of graduates by the number of students available for graduation

Placement Rates: an average of 75% of those graduates self-reporting are using the skills they learned at CCMCC. Placement rates are calculated by dividing the number of graduates employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment in each program

Externship Outcomes: 90% of students complete the externship portion of the program successfully. Of those completing, 55% received an outstanding rating, 30% received an above average rating and 15% an average rating. Externship outcomes calculated by dividing the number of students who begin an externship by the number of students who successfully complete an externship
