

NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund. The institution for all students without penalty or obligation, shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100), if the notice of cancellation to made prior to or on the first day of instruction.

Cancellation will occur when the student gives written notice of cancellation to the school at the address specified on the enrollment agreement. You can do this by mail, hand delivery, or telegram. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that you no longer wish to be bound y this agreement.

You may withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a pro-rate refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charges if you have completed 60% or less of the instruction. Refunds will be paid within 7 days of cancellation or withdrawal.

CANCELLATION AFTER COMPLETING 60% OF THE COURSE WILL RESULT IN NO REFUND

Registrants who do not cancel prior to the Class or do not attend are liable for the entire registration fee.

If you cancel, any payments you have made and any negotiable instrument signed by you less the registration fee shall be returned to you within Seven BUSINESS DAYS following the school's receipt of your cancellation notice.

But if the school give you any equipment and textbook, the charge for the textbook is not refundable. You must return the equipment within 5 days of the date you signed a cancellation notice. If you do not return the equipment within this 5 day period, the school may keep an amount of what you paid that equals the cost of the equipment. The total amount charged for each item of equipment shall be separately stated. The amount charged for each item of equipment shall not exceed the equipment's fair market value. The institution shall have the burden of proof to establish the equipment's fair market value. The school is required to refund any amount over that as provided above, and you may keep the equipment.

To cancel the contract for school, mail or deliver a signed and dated copy of this cancellation notice or any other written notice, or send a telegram to California Dealer Training School at 660 Monterey Pass Road #216, Monterey Park, CA 91754.

D. Refund Policy

The student has the right to a full refund of all charges, less a \$50 registration fee if the student cancels this agreement prior to the first day of instruction. The amount retained for the registration fee may not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) if material fee is applicable. In addition, the student may withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a pro rata refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charge if the student has completed **60% or less** of the instruction. For example, if the student completes only 10 hours of a 50-hour course and paid \$500 tuition, the student should receive a refund of \$350. If the school cancels or discontinues a course or educational program, the school will make full refund of all charges. All refund will be paid within 5 business days of course cancellation or student withdrawal. **Cancellation after completing 60% of the course will result in no refund.**

E. Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF)

If the student is not a resident of California or is the recipient of third-party payer tuition and course costs, such as workforce investment voucher or rehabilitation funding, the student is responsible for paying the state assessment amount for the Student Tuition Recovery Fund.

The STRF was established by the legislature to protect California residents attending a private postsecondary institution from losing money if they prepaid tuition and then suffered financial loss because of the school closing, failing to live up to its enrollment agreement, or refusing to pay a court judgment.

To be eligible for STRF, the student must be a “**California resident**” and reside in California at the time the enrollment agreement is signed. Students who are temporarily residing in California for sole purpose of pursuing an education, specifically those who hold student visas, are not considered California residents. To qualify for STRF reimbursement, the student must file a STRF application within one year of receiving notice from the BPPE, they then gave four years from the date of closure to file a STRF application, If a judgment is obtained, the student must file a STRF application within two years of the final judgment. It is important that copies of enrollment agreement, receipts of any other information that document the monies paid to school are kept for reimbursement.
