2. “Students Available for Graduation” means the Student Who Began the Program minus the Students Unavailable for Graduation. “Students Unavailable for Graduation” means student who have who died, been incarcerated or called to active military duty.
3. “Graduates” means Students Who Began the Program who completed the program within 100% of the published length of the program.
4. “Completion Rate” means the Graduates divided by the Students Available for Graduation.

2. Job Placement Rates: The job placement rates for the program as calculated pursuant to CA Post Private Secondary education act of 2009, Section 94929a are as follows:

1. “Number of Students Who Began the Program” means the number of students that began a program who were scheduled to complete the Program within the specified calendar year.

2. “Graduates” means Students Who Began the Program who completed the program within 100% of the published length of the program.
3. “Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
4. “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who are gainfully employed within six months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position. “Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students who leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States or are continuing their education at an accredited or Bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
5. “Placement Rate % of Graduates Employed in the Field” means the rate that is calculated by dividing the Graduates Employed in the Field by the Graduates Available for Employment.

NOTE: The figures above for “Graduates Employed in the Field and Placement Rates % of Graduates Employed in the Field are based on data collected from a survey sent to all 57 graduates in 2011 and all 58 graduates in 2012. Only 12 people responded to the survey in 2011, 11 of which were employed and only 14 graduates responded to the survey in 2012, 9 of which were employed. The Placement Rate % of Graduates Employed in the Field is based on dividing the Graduates Employed in the Field by the Graduates Available for Employment WHETHER OR NOT THEY RESPONDED TO THE SURVEY. In addition, of the 14 Graduates who responded to the 2012 survey, 12 had received CAMTC Certification.
