Prior to enrollment and signing an Enrollment Agreement, the Bureau for Private postsecondary Education approved schools are required to provide students with a School Performance Fact Sheet containing the following information as it relates to their program of study. Students at Nine Star University must initial each item, sign and return the document that includes this information to the Admissions Officer before completing an enrollment agreement. NSU provides this information on our web site as well.

- a) Completion Rate: 100% (The completion rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates by the number of students eligible for graduation.
- b) Placement Rate: 100% (The job placement rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment)
- c) License examination pass rates, 1st time takers 100%
- d) The university makes no claims to applicants regarding salary that may be earned after completing the program. However the 2010 median salary listed for the EDD Labor Market Division category for "Acupuncturist" (Health Diagnosing Practitioners) in California is \$62,650 ****
