<sup>iii</sup> "Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length

<sup>iv</sup> "Completion Rate" is the number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation

<sup>v</sup> "Graduates avail. for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment. Graduates unavailable for employment means graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the U.S., or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution

<sup>vi</sup> "Graduates employed in the field" means graduates who are gainfully employed within six months of graduation in a position for which the skills obtained through the education and training provided by the institution are required or provided a significant advantage to the graduate in obtaining the position

<sup>vii</sup> Placement rate is calculated as follows: the number of graduates employed in the field divided by the number of graduates available for employment

<sup>viii</sup> No. of Students Taking Exam is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the published program length and who took the exam in the reported calendar year for the first time

<sup>ix</sup> No. Who Passed First Exam Taken is the number of students who took and passed the licensing exam in the reported calendar year on the first attempt

<sup>x</sup> Passage Rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who pass the exam the first time that they take it by the number of graduates who took the licensing exam for the first time after completion of the program

<sup>xi</sup> Salary is as reported by the student. Not all graduates reported salary
