**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF  
STATEMENT OF ISSUES**

18 **TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:**

19 1. On or about May 31, 2012, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau)  
20 received an Application for a Renewal of Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited, No.  
21 24878 from Gendarme Institute (Respondent), Institution Code Number 3007651. On or about  
22 October 23, 2015, the Bureau issued Respondent a deficiency letter. Thereafter, Respondent and  
23 the Bureau continued to communicate and correspond regarding Respondent's Application.

24 2. On or about June 24, 2016, the Bureau denied Respondent's Application for a  
25 Renewal of Approval to Operate. In a letter to the Bureau dated August 15, 2016, Respondent  
26 requested an administrative hearing to appeal the Bureau's denial of its application.

1           3.    On or about February 2, 2017, Joanne Wenzel, Chief of the Bureau for Private  
2 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Statement of Issues No.  
3 1002020, solely in her official capacity. After the filing of that Statement of Issues, Respondent  
4 provided additional documents intended to resolve issues of non-compliance in Respondent's  
5 Application.

6           4.    The Bureau hereby withdraws Statement of Issues No. 1002020. The basis for the  
7 withdrawal of this pleading is that Respondent has now provided the documents and other  
8 information necessary for its renewal of licensure.

9           5.    WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No.  
10 1002020 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
