21 1. On or about December 29, 2016, Joanne Wenzel, Chief of the Bureau for Private
22 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs (Bureau), filed Statement of Issues
23 No. 1002211 solely in her official capacity.

24 2. On or about May 14, 2012, the Bureau received an Application for Renewal of
25 Approval to Operate an Institution Non-Accredited (Application #24811) from Topline Beauty
26 College, Inc., President/CEO Hien Nguyen. In January 2013, Tony Do became the new
27 President/owner, changing the name of the school to Topline Beauty College, Inc. On April 9,

1 2014, Tony Do and Topline Beauty College, Inc. (Respondent) submitted a new application. The
2 Bureau denied the application on October 17, 2016. Respondent timely appealed.

3 3. Complainant withdraws the pending Statement of Issues No. 1002211 on the ground
4 that Respondent has now provided the documents and other information necessary for renewal of
5 its approval to operate.

6 4. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No. 1002211
7 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
