On November 20, 2020, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Order of Abatement No. 2021100 (Citation) against Alena M. Nye-Knutson, Owner of English Language Institute (Institution). In attendance were Beth Scott, Enforcement Chief, Dough Smith, Department of Consumer Affairs Legal Counsel, Alena Nye-Knutson, Owner and Executive Director, and Sean Ferguson, Director of Accreditation Regulatory and Compliance.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, section 125.9; California Education Code, section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, section 75020 and section 75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 2021100.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on November 24, 2020, Citation No. 2021100 is <u>affirmed</u> for the following reason(s):

As of October 1, 2020, the Bureau has not received the annual fee nor late payment penalty from the Institution. **Order of Abatement:** The Bureau orders the Institution to submit its annual fees for calendar year 2020 in accordance with 5, CCR section 74006(a)(b) and CEC section 94930.5(g). APPEAL OF CITATION

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this affirmed Citation. You *do*, however, have the right to appeal this affirmed Citation through an Administrative Hearing. A hearing before an Administrative Law Judge will be scheduled and you will be notified of the

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hearing date. The hearing will be held pursuant to Chapter 5 (commencing with section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you do not wish to appeal this affirmed Citation you must withdraw your initial request for an Administrative Hearing, if one was made. Please complete and mail the enclosed <u>Withdrawal –</u> <u>Request for Administrative Hearing</u> within <u>**30 Days**</u> of the date of this decision.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION AND FINE ASSESSMENT

This affirmed Citation is effective on **December 15, 2020**. The order of abatement and payment are due by **January 17, 2021**.

Failure to abate the violation or to pay the administrative fine within the time allowed is grounds for denial of an application for an approval to operate or discipline. The Bureau will promptly take all appropriate action to enforce the Affirmed Citation and recover the civil penalties prescribed therein or found to be due after a hearing.
