1	2. Graduates Do Succeed, Inc., Salvador Franco Sr. and Salvador Franco Jr.
	(Respondent) are represented in this proceeding by attorney Mark Roohk of Moss Law Group,
3	whose address is: 255 South Marengo Avenue, Pasadena, CA 91101.
	4 3. On or about May 4, 1993, the Bureau issued Approval to Operate an Accredited
5	Institution, Code Number 1922081 to Respondent. The Approval to Operate an Accredited
	Institution was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation
7	No. 1000864, and expired on March 15, 2019.
8	JURISDICTION
9	4. Accusation No. 1000864 was filed before the Director of the Department of
10	Consumer Affairs (Director) for the Bureau and is currently pending against Respondent. The
11	Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on
12	September 16, 2019. Respondent timely filed its Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation.
13	A copy of Accusation No. 1000864 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.
14	ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS
15	5. Respondent has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the
16	charges and allegations in Accusation No. 1000864. Respondent also has carefully read, fully
17	discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of Approval to
18	Operate an Accredited Institution and Order.
19	6. Respondent is fully aware of its legal rights in this matter, including the right to a
20	hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to confront and cross-examine
21	the witnesses against it; the right to present evidence and to testify on its own behalf; the right to
22	the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of
23	documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other
24	rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
25	7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and
26	every right set forth above.

1	<u>CULPABILITY</u>		
2	8. Respondent understands that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 1000864,		
3	if proven at a hearing, constitute cause for imposing discipline upon its Approval to Operate an		
4	Accredited Institution.		
	5 9. For the purpose of resolving the Accusation without the expense and uncertainty of		
e	further proceedings, Respondent agrees that, at a hearing, Complainant could establish a factual		
7	basis for the charges in the Accusation and that those charges constitute cause for discipline.		
8	Respondent hereby gives up its right to contest that cause for discipline exists based on those		
9	charges.		
10	10. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation, it enables the Director to		
11	issue his order accepting the surrender of Respondent's Approval to Operate an Accredited		
12	Institution without further process.		
13	<u>CONTINGENCY</u>		
14	11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Director or the Director's		
15	designee. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and Bureau staff may		
16	communicate directly with the Director and staff regarding this stipulation and surrender, without		
17	notice to, or participation by Respondent or its counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondent		
18	understands and agrees that it may not withdraw its agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation		
19	prior to the time the Director considers and acts upon it. If the Director fails to adopt this		
20	stipulation as the Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate an		
21	Accredited Institution and Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall		
22	be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Director shall not be disqualified		
23	from further action by having considered this matter.		
24	12. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile		
25	copies of this Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate an Accredited Institution and Order,		
26	including PDF and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the		
27	originals.

1 3. This Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate an Accredited Institution and Order 2 is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate an Accredited Institution and Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by 6 7 an authorized representative of each of the parties.

8 14. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Director may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following 9 Order: 10

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Approval to Operate an Accredited Institution, Code 12 Number 1922081, issued to Respondent Graduates Do Succeed, Inc., Salvador Franco Sr. and 13 14 Salvador Franco Jr. is surrendered and accepted by the Bureau.

15 1. The surrender of Respondent's Approval to Operate an Accredited Institution and the acceptance of the surrendered Approval to Operate by the Bureau shall constitute the imposition 16 of discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall 17 become a part of Respondent's approval history with the Bureau. The acceptance of the 18 19 Stipulated Surrender of Approval to Operate an Accredited Institution shall not preclude the filing of any civil claims against Respondent related to the allegations in Accusation No. 1000864. 20

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2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as an approved school in California as of the effective date of the Director's Decision and Order.

23 3. If Respondent ever files an application for school approval in the State of California, the Bureau shall treat it as a new application. Respondent must comply with all the laws, 24 regulations and procedures of a surrendered approval to operate in effect at the time the 25 26 application is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 1000864 27 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when the Director determines whether to grant or deny the application.

1	4. Respondent may not apply for a new school approval for three (3) years from the		
2	effective date of this Decision. Respondent shall pay the Bureau the costs of investigation and		
1	enforcement in this matter in the amount of \$17,503.87 prior to issuance of any new approval to		
4	operate.
