The catalog failed to include the above statement verbatim. To remedy the violation, the institution shall update their catalog to include the required statement verbatim. A copy of the revised catalog shall be submitted with the institution's response to the NTC and the last page of this document within the specified time frame. §94909 - Minimum Requirements for (a)(8) (A) Admissions policies, including the institution's policies School Catalog. regarding the acceptance of credits earned at other institutions or through challenge examinations and achievement tests, admissions requirements for ability-to-benefit students, and a list describing any transfer or articulation agreements between the institution and any other college or university that provides for the transfer of credits earned in the program of instruction. The institution's catalog included conflicting cancellation and withdrawal policies. Page 11 of the catalog has the correct cancellation policy. Pages 18 and 19 have a different cancellation policy. The timeframe students have to return equipment for a refund ranges from 10 days to 30 days to 45 days. One date needs to be listed. To remedy the violation, the institution shall correct their catalog to reflect correct cancellation and withdrawal policies. The institution shall also list only one date for return of equipment.
