**Nature and Facts of the Violation(s):**

§94904 - Ability to Benefit Students.	<p>(a) Before an ability-to-benefit student may execute an enrollment agreement, the institution shall have the student take an independently administered examination from the list of examinations prescribed by the United States Department of Education pursuant to Section 484(d) of the federal Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. Sec. 1070a et seq.) as it is, from time to time, amended. The student shall not enroll unless the student achieves a score, as specified by the United States Department of Education, demonstrating that the student may benefit from the education and training being offered.</p> <p><b>Two (2) student files contained an ability-to-benefit test that the institution failed to produce contracts verifying they were independently administered.</b></p>

§71720 - Faculty.	<p>(b)(2) Each instructor shall maintain their knowledge by completing continuing education courses in his or her subject area, classroom management or other courses related to teaching.</p> <p><b>The instructor file for the institutions certificate program failed to include documentation of continuing education.</b></p>
§71920 - Student Records.	<p>(b)(1) (A) Verification of high school completion or equivalency or other documentation establishing the student's ability to do college level work, such as successful completion of an ability-to-benefit test.</p> <p><b>Two (2) student files contained an ability-to-benefit test that the institution failed to produce contracts verifying they were independently administered. Four (4) out of five (5) graduate files did not contain documentation establishing the student's ability to do college level work.</b></p>
