In addition to any specific standards for an educational program, the admissions standards must specify as applicable that:</p> <p>(1) Each student admitted to an undergraduate degree program, or a diploma program, shall possess a high school diploma or its equivalent, or otherwise successfully take and pass the relevant examination as required by section 94904 of the Code.</p> <p>Institution failed to verify completion of a high school diploma/GED prior to enrolling students into the institution.</p>
§71920. Student Records.	<p>(a) The institution shall maintain a file for each student who enrolls in the institution whether or not the student completes the educational service.</p> <p>(1) Written records and transcripts of any formal education or training, testing, or experience that are relevant to the student's qualifications for admission to the institution or the institution's award of credit or acceptance of transfer credits including the following:</p> <p>(A) Verification of high school completion or equivalency or other documentation establishing the student's ability to do college level work, such as successful completion of an ability-to-benefit test;</p> <p>Institution failed to document completion of high school/GED completion prior to enrolling students into the institution.</p>


