Nature and Facts of the Violation(s):

Education Code	Subsection and Description
§94902 - General Enrollment Requirements.	(a) A student shall enroll solely by means of executing an enrollment agreement. The enrollment agreement shall be signed by the student and by an authorized employee of the institution. Several student enrollment agreements were lacking signatures by the student and/or the institution.
§94902 - General Enrollment Requirements.	(b) An enrollment agreement is not enforceable unless all of the following requirements are met: (3) Prior to the execution of the enrollment agreement, the student and the institution have signed and dated the information required to be disclosed in the Student Performance Fact Sheet pursuant to subdivisions (a) to (d), inclusive, of Section 94910. Each of these items in the Student Performance Fact Sheet shall include a line for the student to initial and shall be initialed and dated by the student. Several Student Performance Fact Sheets in student files did not contain student signatures. In addition, the Student Performance Fact Sheets in the student's files were lacking the institution signature and dated.



Code of Regulations	Subsection and Description
§71750 - Withdrawals and Refunds.	(a) Every institution shall make refunds that are no less than the refunds required under the Act and this Division. Student files were lacking information and verification with regard to refund. (c) A pro rata refund pursuant to section 94919(c) or 94920(d) or 94927 of the Code shall be no less than the total amount owed by the student for the portion of the educational program provided subtracted from the amount paid by the student Student files were lacking information and verification with regard to refund.

§71920 - Student Records.	<p>(b) In addition to the requirements of section 94900, the file shall contain all of the following pertinent student records:</p> <p>(1) Written records and transcripts of any formal education or training, testing, or experience that are relevant to the student's qualifications for admission to the institution or the institution's award of credit or acceptance of transfer credits including the following:</p> <p>(A) Verification of high school completion or equivalency or other documentation establishing the student's ability to do college level work, such as successful completion of an ability-to-benefit test;</p> <p>Student's file was lacking verification of high school completion or equivalency or other documentation establishing the student's ability to do college level work.</p>
§71920 - Student Records.	<p>(b) In addition to the requirements of section 94900, the file shall contain all of the following pertinent student records:</p> <p>(9) A document showing the total amount of money received from or on behalf of the student and the date or dates on which the money was received;</p> <p>Several student files were lacking documentation showing the total amount of money received from or on behalf of the student and the date or dates on which the money was received</p> <p>(10) A document specifying the amount of a refund, including the amount refunded for tuition and the amount for other itemized charges, the method of calculating the refund, the date the refund was made, and the name and address of the person or entity to which the refund was sent.</p> <p>Several student files were lacking documentation specifying the amount of a refund, including the amount refunded for tuition and the amount for other itemized charges, the method of calculating the refund, the date the refund was made, and the name and address of the person or entity to which the refund was sent.</p>

IMPORTANT COMPLIANCE NOTICE
