94909. Minimum Requirements for School Catalog	(a) Prior to enrollment, an institution shall provide a prospective student, either in writing or electronically, with a school catalog containing, at a minimum, all of the following: (9) The schedule of total charges for a period of attendance and an estimated schedule of total charges for the entire educational program. STRF charges are not contained in the catalog.

Code of Regulations	Subsection and Description
76120. Amount of STRF Assessment.	(a) Each qualifying institution shall collect an assessment of fifty cents (\$.50) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) of institutional charges, rounded to the nearest thousand dollars, from each student in an educational program who is a California resident or is enrolled in a residency program. For institutional charges of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or less, the assessment is fifty cents (\$.50). On page 3 of the enrollment agreement, the STRF Assessment is shown as \$2.50 per \$1,000. (Effective 01/01/13 the STRF assessment rates changed from \$2.50 to \$0.50 per \$1,000 total institutional charges.)

(b) In addition to the requirements of section 94900, the file shall contain all of the following pertinent student records: (5) In addition to the requirements of section 94900(b) of the Code, a transcript showing all of the following: (E) The name, address, website address, and telephone number of

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
